

Serena moves to third round! Australian Open

Serena Williams moves forward to the third round of the 2007 Australian Open, as she continues to make her comeback.

Williams beat Anne Kremer of Luxembourg 7-6 (7-4), 6-2. As a seven time grand slam winner, and a two time Australian Open champion she is showing her relentless passion for the game during these hot games in Australia. She was off most of last year recovering from a knee injury; consequently her ranking has moved to its lowest.

Her next opponent will be Nadia Petrova.

It's definitely a step up, I feel excited to go into the match. I feel ready," Williams said.

"I think I lost a little focus like when I was up 4-0 in the second. I started daydreaming. I'm too experienced to daydream at that stage of a match."

Petrova and Williams have played each other six times, with Petrova beating Williams only once.
